First Peoples' Assembly of Victoria election enrolment now open

Enrolment has opened for Aboriginal Victorians to elect the First Peoples' Assembly of Victoria.

The Assembly will be set up this year, and the Victorian Government has committed in law to work with the Assembly to take the Treaties process forward.

Enrolling to vote will mean that when voting takes place, between 8-21 July, Aboriginal communities can have their say on who is on the Assembly.

Enrolment is easy and can be done from a smart phone in about 5 minutes.

You can [download enrolment forms](#) to print out and return.

You can also enrol in person at one of the [Victorian Treaty Advancement Commission](#) events over the coming months, or by visiting one of 12 Aboriginal Community Controlled Organisations across the state hosting an Assembly Election Officer.

You can enrol to vote if you are a Victorian Traditional Owner or an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander who has lived in Victoria for at least three of the last five years.
