Indigenous Employment Partners (IEP) is proud to announce the newest member of our board Diana David, a proud Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Women from the Southern Kaanju Nation Central Cape York Peninsula and Kulkagau Ya lama (Yam Is) Western Torres Strait Islands, North Queensland.

Diana was appointed to the role of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Reconciliation Victoria in November 2018 and is the first ever Indigenous CEO for Reconciliation Victoria. And as CEO has been working alongside Indigenous Employment Partners since.

Diana has a broad range of academic and professional credentials, including working with the Cape York Institute for Policy and Leadership and a participant of the Cape York Leadership Academy. She brings extensive Government sector experience to the IEP board and prior to working with Reconciliation Victoria, Diana held a position with the Victorian Treaty Advancement Commission (VTAC).

She has worked extensively in Aboriginal Affairs with Aboriginal Victoria (AV) and has always been interested in the Reconciliation journey. Passionate about developing campaigns with a strong cultural lens across them.
